

admission checklist

Canterbury seeks to attract a variety of students who will be successful in our program, whose families support the school's mission and philosophy, and whose enrollment will enable Canterbury to reflect the social, economic, racial, cultural, and religious mix of the greater Greensboro community.

All Applicants:

- Complete the application form and mail it with the \$75 application fee. (If the application fee poses a financial concern for your family, please contact the Admission Office.) As a general rule, students admitted to kindergarten have reached the age of five by August 31st in the year in which they would like to attend.

Kindergarten Applicants:

- Distribute the Teacher Recommendation form to your child's preschool teacher. The form will be mailed to you in December or can be accessed from the Admission section of our website.
- Bring your child for his or her observation in January or February. Instructions and your child's observation time will be mailed to you in December.

1st-5th Grade Applicants:

- Distribute the Teacher Recommendation form to your child's teacher. The form can be accessed from the Admission section of our website or requested from the Admission Office.
- Provide a copy of all previous educational records (including report cards and standardized testing) to Canterbury. The Transcript Release form can be accessed from the Admission section of our website or requested from the Admission Office.

- Make arrangements with the Admission Office for your child's classroom visit. As a general rule, classroom visits usually begin in late January.

6th-8th Grade Applicants:

- Distribute two Teacher Recommendation forms (one for math and one for language arts) to your child's teachers. The forms can be accessed from the Admission section of our website or requested from the Admission Office.
- Provide a copy of all previous educational records (including report cards and standardized testing) to Canterbury. The Transcript Release form can be accessed from the Admission section of our website or requested from the Admission Office.
- Make arrangements for your child's classroom visit and testing. A middle school representative will coordinate the schedule.

While not required, all families are strongly encouraged to attend an Open House or schedule an interview and tour with the Admission Office. An Open House schedule is enclosed.
