Casa Azul announces Greensboro's first annual Día de los Muertos or Day of the Dead celebration November 1-2, 2011 in Greensboro. The celebration will introduce and share the traditional Mexican Day of the Dead celebration with the community.

An Aztec ritual which dates back more than 3,000 years, Day of the Dead celebrates death and the continuation of life by honoring deceased relatives and friends. In preparation for the celebration, Casa Azul will conduct a family oriented workshop at ArtQuest on **Sunday, October 30<sup>th</sup>** to share the history of Day of the Dead, learn about traditional altars, decorate sugar skulls and make paper flowers. This free workshop is open to ages 7 and up and will take place from 2:00-4:00pm. On November 1-2, Casa Azul will present a Día de los Muertos exhibition on the first floor and outdoor patio at the Greensboro Cultural Arts Center.
