Canterbury Cougars "Paws" to Help CROP Stop Hunger

On October 22, 2011, Canterbury School will host an annual Mini CROP Hunger Walk to raise funds for hungry and homeless people locally and throughout the world. Church World Service sponsors the walk nationally. Since 1946, Church World Service has provided money for refugees, disaster relief, and self-help projects in more than 80 countries around the world. Its work, through local churches and faith groups, often extends long after the work of FEMA and the Red Cross has terminated. Locally, the walk is sponsored by Greensboro Urban Ministry, a faith-based organization providing services and support to the hungry, homeless and people in need in the Greater Greensboro area. Church World Service will distribute seventy-five percent of the CROP Walk funds. Twenty-five percent of the money raised stays here in Greensboro to help support the work of Urban Ministry.

If you would like to join the walk, please request a CROP Walk "Sponsor Form" from your child's classroom teacher. Registration begins at 8:30am at Berry Hall with the walk beginning at 9:00am. It is only a 1-mile walk and takes around 30 minutes to complete.

If you are unable to attend the walk, please consider making a donation to CWS CROP and send it to school in an envelope marked CROP Walk.
