8th Grade Sermons

Since 2000, 8th grade students have sought to use what they learned throughout their time at Canterbury and in their theology course to articulate their theological views in meaningful and creative ways. At first, all of the students built chapel models, but in 2004 the students were offered the option of writing and delivering a sermon in chapel. Lower School Christmas Program



This year's program is called "**Christmas in the Country.**" As in years past, each grade level will sing a song as part of the program.

Kindergarten: overalls or blue denim jeans, red or green plaid or solid shirt, cowboy boots or tennis shoes.

1st grade: "Cowboy/cowgirl" wear. (hats, bandana, denim, plaid, or similar casual shirt, blue denim jeans or skirt), cowboy boots or tennis shoes. Please no t-shirts or toy guns/holsters.

2nd through 5th grade (band and chorus): "Country" clothing (flannel, checked, plaid, denim or similar casual shirt or dress, overalls, blue jeans, or denim skirt, bandana). Cowboy boots or sneakers. Please no t-shirts.

We do not expect anyone to go out and buy anything especially for this program -- do your best with what you have.

Students arrive at 6:15pm and sit in their assigned spots. The program lasts about 45 minutes. The start time in Berry Hall is 6:30pm. Please have your child/ren give you their coats to hold during the performance. The 5th grade band will play first and then will sit in the audience with their parents, so you may save them a seat.

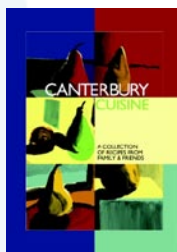
Because of seating limitations at the evening performance, we invite our grandparents to attend the daytime performance at 11:00am the same day.

Lunar Eclipse



On **December 10, 2011**, we will have a special opportunity to view a lunar eclipse. During a lunar eclipse, the Earth passes directly between the Sun and the full moon, casting its shadow on the face of the moon for a period of

time. During the hours of a lunar eclipse, anyone on the right side of Earth can view the spectacle.

The upcoming lunar eclipse will be visible from Greensboro as long as the weather is clear. From our point of view, the eclipse will not be a total one. **The moon will enter the Earth's shadow around 6:32am. The moon sets at 7:17am. During this time, a partial lunar eclipse will be visible.**
