This is a gentle reminder about the school's expectations for carpool. First and foremost, safety is of the utmost importance, which is why we ask that you refrain from using cell phones during any carpool time. In the morning, please note that the carpool line is drop-and-go. Should you wish to walk in with your child, please park in one of the parking lots and carefully cross the carpool lanes with your child.

For afternoon carpool, **all** parents are expected to go through the carpool line. If there is some special circumstance- such as a doctor's appointment- that requires you to pick up your child and leave immediately after school, then we ask that you find a parking spot and walk to the chapel to pick up your child. This request meets a particularly important safety need.
