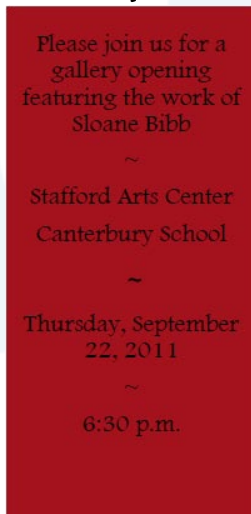
# Important Calendar Changes
