Statement of Student Responsibility

I understand and will abide by the policies that govern the use of the Canterbury School Internet System. I further understand that any violation of the regulations is unethical and may constitute a criminal offense or violation of Canterbury School’s Behavior Expectation Policy and Honor Code. Should I commit any violation, my access privileges may be revoked, and school disciplinary and/or appropriate legal action may be taken.

The following behaviors are prohibited:

- Using the Internet without permission from a teacher or for non-educational purposes
- Using your personal e-mail account while at school without permission of a teacher
- Sending or receiving instant messages of any sort while at school
- Sending material that is illegal
- Sending messages which include vulgarities, swear words, or other inappropriate language or images
- Using the Internet to harass, insult, or attack others
- Displaying offensive messages or pictures
- Giving your password to another person and / or using another person’s password
- Changing desktop or other settings, including adding widgets
- Trespassing in another person’s folders, work, or files
- Downloading programs without permission from a teacher
- Violating license agreements and / or copyright laws
- Using the Canterbury network to damage other computers, computer systems or networks
- Accessing Google images by using international extensions (such as .uk)
